

NY Specialty Centers for Oral Care. The CT & NY Specialty Centers for Oral Care are specialty practices in veterinary companion animal dentistry and oral surgery. These practices serve primarily the New England and Mid-Atlantic states. Dr. DeForge lectures on small animal dentistry and oral surgery emphasizing practical applications for the general veterinary practitioner.

In 1995, Dr. DeForge published and edited the first issue of Veterinary Dentistry Report (VDR), an encapsulated digest of the common problems in dentistry and oral surgery faced by the general practitioner. The digest emphasizes dental products and equipment of clinical importance to the practicing veterinarian.

As a Fellow of the Academy of Veterinary Dentistry and clinical researcher, Dr. DeForge studies techniques and materials that may improve or enhance veterinary dentistry. Fixed crown prosthodontics, guided tissue regeneration with bioceramic bone grafts, and implantology advancements are his major professional interests in veterinary dentistry. He teaches wet labs in veterinary dental radiology

and film reading to assist veterinarians and their technicians in their post-graduate journey in veterinary dentistry. Dr. DeForge received the 1996 Northeast Practitioner of the Year Award from the American Animal Hospital Association and was the recipient of the American Veterinary Dental College 's Peter Emily Resident Award sponsored by Pharmacia and Upjohn Animal Health. This annual award has been given to an individual exhibiting high ideals and a commitment to further the field of veterinary dentistry.

Dr. DeForge and Dr. Ben Colmery, Dipl. AVDC are co-editors of An Atlas of Veterinary Dental Radiology (Iowa State University Press, January 2000). This textbook, with contributions from twenty-nine veterinary specialists, emphasizes the normal oral x-ray structures as well as all abnormal x-ray problems in the major intra-disciplines of oral care.

Dr. DeForge has recently joined the East End Veterinary Emergency and Specialty Center as a veterinary dental specialist.
